WSQ Develop a Risk Management Implementation Plan

This course will instill learners with knowledge and skills to be a Risk Management Champion / Risk Assessment Leader for the organization in reducing the risk at source by managing risk management process at the workplace, in compliance with WSH (Risk Management) Regulations and Code of Practice on WSH Risk Management Second Revision 2015.

It involves developing a practical risk management implementation plan for the organization. The course provides learners the opportunity to practice and apply knowledge on conducting hazard identification, apply risk assessment methodology to evaluate risk, implement the hierarchy of risk control and communication of hazards through classroom discussion and practice.

This is one of the bizSAFE modules that leads to the award of WSQ Statement of Attainment.
